### Class of '55 --- Leading the Way!

The Class of 1955 held their 60<sup>th</sup> reunion on August 22 with some of its members participating in a tour of CNHS. It was my (Hedy George) pleasure and honor to give this tour as the Bull Dog Alumni Director. Even though these Bull Dog alumni attended high school at the "Central" building on 7<sup>th</sup> Street, there was interest in seeing the new additions and upgrades at the 25<sup>th</sup> Street school, and of course, Memorial Gym. The group moved through the hallways with lots of engaging conversation and finally came upon our pride and joy, Memorial Gym. Throughout the years, some things have changed since that first game was played in November, 1954. The most recent changes are the new gym floor and lower-level bleachers installed this past spring. The original gym floor lasted over 61 years! Wow!

As the group moved up to the Maple Street hallway, older team pictures and trophy cases were on full display. One of particular interest was the large picture of the first team to play in Memorial Gym, the '54-'55 basketball team. (21-5 record along with sectional and regional champs) Unfortunately, this team picture has been damaged over the years with water spots in several places. (Very few of the pictures in the front hallway have glass coverings.) One of the alumni, Jim Strietelmeier, mentioned he has a smaller picture that could possibly replace the damaged one on the wall. This was exciting news because this definitely is a picture with historic significance for CHS/CNHS! The story ended better than expected because the smaller picture Mr. Strietelmeier gave to me was scanned and made into a larger picture that also included the team members' names. It looks terrific and will soon be hung in place of the damaged picture in the Maple Street hallway of Memorial Gym!

#### Psi lota Xi --- Serving the Community

Tucked into a quiet neighborhood at 8<sup>th</sup> & California Streets in Columbus, you'll find the **Psi lota Xi Thrift Shop**.



The shop is owned and operated by the local (Epsilon) chapter of the Psi lota Xi Philanthropic Sorority. The "Psi Otes", as they are known among themselves and others in the community, are a local group who are (as their brochure states) "women with a desire to be of service in a cooperative effort with the community."



Currently, there are 54 active members along with another significant group of auxiliary members. Many of these ladies are Bull Dogs, and many of the ones who aren't Bull Dogs themselves have children and grandchildren who are! They all take regular turns working at the thrift shop, and all proceeds from the shop support their community giving.

Since 1994, the Columbus Chapter has contributed almost \$200,000 to community projects. Many of these projects are education-related and have touched countless Bull Dogs and their families over the years. Another section of their brochure proudly states "supporting communities in speech, hearing, art, music, and literature." It's in these areas around county schools that you'll see the fruits of these ladies' labors demonstrated. And you'll seldom know it was they who enabled a program or an opportunity.

Their mission to the community is to "enrich the lives of those around us." While providing residents an affordable place to shop, profits may purchase books for school libraries, provide scholarships to middle and high school students, or support a wide range of projects. Some recent projects involving the BCSC have included High School "Arts" programs, speech/language/hearing therapists and equipment at elementary level, school books and musical instruments for elementary students, and Elsie Sweeney Psi Iota Xi High School Music scholarships.

If you are involved in an area where you think the Psi Otes might be able to assist one of your programs, you can call or stop by the Thrift Shop and make arrangements to pick-up an application form for a grant.

### You can donate stock - and save on taxes!

Now you can support the Bull Dog Alumni Association and get a tax break. For most individuals, donations of highly appreciated shares of stock earn a tax deduction of the full market value of the stock on the date of the donation – yet the donor is not required to pay capital gains tax on the difference between the market value and the amount the donor originally paid (tax basis). Check with your tax advisor to make sure no special circumstances would disqualify you from this beneficial tax treatment.

To donate stock, you should request a stock donation or transfer by your broker. In most cases your broker will need the following information:


